

## QUICK TIPS FOR CHOOSING THE RIGHT MATH COURSE IN GRADE 11

1. **I want to graduate high school:** You need to pass a Math 11 course.
2. **I am not planning on post-secondary education:** You can take any of the three math courses.
3. **I am going to study humanities or the arts in post-secondary:** You need to take Foundations 11 or Pre-calculus 11.
4. **I am going to study commerce, math or science in post-secondary:** You need to take Pre-calculus 11.
5. **I really struggle with math:** You need to take Workplace Mathematics 11.
6. **I am really good at math:** You have two choices: Foundations 11 or Pre-Calculus 11. Your choice depends on which university program you intend to enter.

\*UVIC and UBC require Foundations of Math 11 and Foundations of Math 12 or Pre-calculus 11 for entrance. **Please view individual college and university course guides for specific requirements.**

## EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENT

Math courses at the grade 9 level and beyond require the use of a calculator. As a minimum requirement, students should have a scientific calculator. The **Sharp EL – 510R** is most suitable.
